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## REFURBISHMENT OF YOUTH CENTRES IN FARAFENNI AND JANJANGBUREH

### Project Background

The Youth Empowerment Project (YEP) is a five-year initiative which aims to support the economic development of The Gambia and create jobs for young people. YEP fosters the employability and self-employment opportunities for youth, with a focus on vocational training and the creation of micro and small-sized enterprises and improving employment opportunities in selected sectors through value addition and market linkages. The project is implemented by International Trade Centre (ITC) under the leadership of the Ministry of Trade, Industry, Regional Integration & Employment (MOTIE) and the Ministry of Youth and Sports. The project is funded by the European Union Emergency Trust Fund for stability and addressing root causes of irregular migration and displaced persons in Africa.

### About the Youth Centres

Youth Centres are spaces that act as catalysts for social cohesion in many ways. First, they are a community hub and platform in which youth and children can network and express their views on issues affecting them. Second, they can offer thematic programmes in areas relevant to the youth (e.g. Health, ICT, Entrepreneurship, Livelihoods). Third, they will offer sports and entertainment activities that promote community cohesion and youth wellbeing. Finally, they will also be a source of revenue generation to the community through renting of facilities and equipment, as well as income generating activities.
